INSPECTION & VERIFICATION OPERATOR UTILITIES WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

The Inspection & Verification Operator position performs front line support for the Collections section of the City of Topeka Utilities Water Pollution Control Division.

This position is responsible for operating and maintaining a closed circuit television truck to assess the condition of existing pipe infrastructure and inspect new construction before it is accepted for maintenance. Conducts flow monitoring, building inspections, dyed water testing and performs daily data entry to accomplish all tasks associated with the operation, maintenance, inspection, installation and repair of the City's wastewater, storm water and flood control system assets and facilities.

Essential Duties:

- Operates and maintains closed circuit television equipment and trucks to complete work orders relating to the inspection and assessment of existing storm and waste water infrastructure.
- Provide Quality Assurance and Quality Control inspections following maintenance work.
- Provide support to internal and external staff regarding back-ups, blockages and voids.
- Inspect and assess new construction for quality and workmanship prior to the City accepting improvements for maintenance.
- Accurate and timely reports findings, documents and report discrepancies in GIS, reports failing and obstructed connections to management.

Minimum qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent, completion of CUES Technical School preferred.
- Must have a minimum of 5 years' experience as a collection system equipment operator.
- Must have a minimum of 3 years' experience working with a CCTV truck and crew.
- Must possess and maintain a valid KS Class A driver's license with Tanker Endorsement.
- Must possess a Forklift Operator Certification.
- Possess and maintain a valid Class IV Collection System Operator certification from the Kansas Water and Environment Association or obtain within six months of hire date.
- Possess and maintain a valid PACP certification or obtain within six months of hire date. PACP = Pipeline Assessment Certification Program - a nationally recognized certification issued by NASSCO (North Association of Sewer Service Companies).
